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Eric L. Stevens PhD is a Staff Fellow in the Office of Regulatory Science at the Center for Food Safety and Applied Nutrition. He received his Ph.D. in Human Genetics and Molecular Biology from The Johns Hopkins School of Medicine with an emphasis on human population genetics and estimating genetic relatedness. From 2013 – 2014 he completed a Postdoctoral Fellowship analyzing RNA sequencing data to find differentially expressed genes and isoforms related to schizophrenia.

In 2014 he became an FDA Commissioner's Fellow. Dr Stevens' current work continues to focus on engaging other federal and international stakeholders in applying WGS methodologies to track foodborne outbreaks through CFSAN's GenomeTrakr. He travels extensively to both domestic and international locations to represent the Office of Regulatory Science and CFSAN in how FDA is using WGS for its food program.
